Commission scolaire francophone TNO



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Introduction

The Commission scolaire francophone was established under the Education Act of the government of the Northwest Territories by order of the Minister in 2000. The Commission scolaire francophone, Territoires du Nord-Ouest shall offer French first language instruction in the education districts within its jurisdiction.

- The Commission scolaire francophone offers preschool to Grade 12 levels in both schools in Yellowknife and Hay River. Ecole Allain St-Cyr is located in Yellowknife and École Boréale is located in Hay River.
- As of September 30 2015, the Commission scolaire francophone des TNO had 216.5 students enrolled compared to 222.5 students on September 30 2014.
- The Commission scolaire francophone des TNO has 38 employees

Programs and Services

General description of budget categories:

Administration

The administration section includes a budget for salaries and benefits for the Commission scolaire francophone TNO (CSFTNO) staff, honoraria for Board Trustees and administration O&M expenses.

School Programs

This section includes a budget to operate the school system such as salaries and benefits for classroom teachers, consultants, secretaries and custodians. It also covers professional development, materials and supplies for the classroom and student transportation.

Inclusive Schooling

The budget for inclusive schooling is to provide support systems and services to enable all students to be included as full participants in regular, age-appropriate classes. This includes salaries and benefits for program support teachers and education assistants, professional development, materials and supplies for the classroom in both schools.

Aboriginal Language and Cultural Based Education Programs (ALCBE)

The budget for ALCBE supports salaries and benefits for the Aboriginal Culture specialists to plan and organize school activities and O&M for these activities.

Facility and Maintenance

The budget for Infrastructure covers the operating and maintenance costs for the schools not covered by the GNWT. This section also includes staffing and other employee benefits costs to the CSFTNO.

Budget Overview and Highlights

The Department of Education, Culture and Employment provides the majority of revenue for the CSFTNO. Total expected revenue is \$6,025,000 and the projected expense is \$6,202,000. This leaves a projected operating deficit of \$176,000.

The budget approved by the Board of Trustees of the CSFTNO represents its commitment to offer quality French first language instruction from preschool to grade 12.

Budget highlights:

- Increase in school staffing.
- The majority of the projected deficit is to support of the 2015-2020 Strategic Plan. These funds are taken from the CSFTNO Accumulated Surplus.
 - \$86,000 Implementation of the preschool program
 - \$30,000 Communication and marketing plan
 - \$40,000 Update on governance policies and other strategic plan objectives.
